Do you know how to perform a technical animal rescue? This course is designed to meet the NFPA 1670 Chapter 17 standards on Animal Technical Rescue which covers but is not limited to:

- *Identify attachment points to the animal, and appropriate positioning with minimal injury to the animal and responders*
- *How to lift/move large animals*
- *How to use rope rescue systems to move animals along a horizontal path above an obstacle or projection*
- *Understanding animal behavior cues and recognizing the need to be adaptable in our actions to keep animal and rescuers safe*
- *How to move an animal packaged in an animal litter or sling up and over edges/ledges*
- *How to team with and utilize Veterinarians who are trained in Technical Animal Rescue*
